Annual Filings for New Jersey Nonprofit Organizations

1. Internal Revenue Service

Form: Annual Return Form 990

Due Date: 4 ½ months after end of fiscal year

Public Charities: If revenues under \$25,000, file Form 990-N electronically.
If revenues between \$25,000 and \$100,000, submit Form 990EZ.

Private Foundations: Submit Form 990PF, regardless of revenues.

2. New Jersey Attorney General

Form: CRI-200 or CRI-300R and copy of IRS Form 990 or 990-EZ

Due Date: 6 months after end of fiscal year

Filing Fee: \$0-\$250 (depending on gross contributions)

Notes: If gross contributions over \$25,000, or the organization contracted with a professional fundraiser, file form CRI-300R.

Organizations that file form CRI-300R and have over \$250,000 in gross **revenues** must also submit a certified audit.
